Loan Payment Options Expanding



Beginning in January 2018, a new loan payment option will be available through CU-Online Account Access. In addition to the current options, members will now be able to make a payment online from another financial institution (FI) through their CU-Online Account Access or through the Go ISUFCU mobile app.

To access the new loan payment option, members will need to login to their CU-Online account and navigate to the Transfer

Funds tab, External Transfers, Loan Payment. Members will need the routing number and account number of the financial institution from which they wish to pay.

All the Ways to Pay Your Loan at ISUFCU

- Payroll Deduction
- Scheduled Automatic Transfer
- ACH (Automated Clearing House)
- CUOnline transfer
- In Person
- Online Bill Pay from another Financial Institution
- Transfer from Account at another Financial Institution

To initiate CUOnline Account access using your computer, enter your member number as the username and the last four digits of your social security number as the password. Using the mobile app, you need to select Sign Up in the bottom left corner and follow the prompts using your member number as the user ID and the last four digits of your social security number as the PIN. The system will then walk you through the steps of registering and creating your own personalized username and password. Carelessness Can Cost You

Many Americans are concerned about someone stealing their credit card, check, or debit card numbers, but they may be ignoring one easy way thieves can access financial accounts: receipts.

Disregarding receipts that have valuable information greatly increases the risk of credit and debit card fraud. Thieves easily can find receipts with valid account numbers in trash cans. Some easy steps you can take to prevent thieves from stealing your financial information:

- * Shred all preapproved credit offers, credit and debit card receipts, insurance forms, financial statements, and other paperwork containing personal and financial information;
- * Check credit union statements and other financial statements monthly for discrepancies and order a credit report once a year to make sure no one else is using your personal information to obtain credit cards or services;
- * Don't print your Social Security number on your checks and don't carry your Social Security card in your wallet; and
- * Be hesitant about giving personal or financial information over the telephone—make sure you know the caller and know how the information will be used.

Sign Up for E-Statements Today

View your monthly financial statements online instead of receiving them through the mail. You can view, print, or save your last 12 months of financial statements. Reduce your chances of being a victim of mail fraud and receive your ISU Credit Union statement electronically. You can receive notification by e-mail and enjoy safety, timeliness, and convenience.
